Student/Athlete Scholarship Award Form

Wisconsin Junior Race League (WJR) is a non-profit organization that promotes healthy competition through downhill ski racing. Wisconsin Junior Race League is offering a \$500.00 Scholarship to any boy and girl WJR participant with at least three years competing in the WJR program to further their education and pursue a productive and rewarding life. This scholarship by no means a sponsorship to pursue skiing endeavors.

A Scholarship Committee upon review of the scholarship application and letters will determine one recipient and the award. The Scholarship Committee will be composed of the following:

Criteria for Selection:

1. Applicant must be a current WJR member of good standing and a graduating senior of a High School and enrolled in any accredited college, university, vocational or trade school.
2. Applicant must have demonstrated such qualities as initiative, honesty, integrity, and community service as well as a strong work ethic.
3. Financial-need will not be an absolute criterion for the award, but may be taken into consideration by the Scholarship Committee.
4. Applicants must submit the application form along with one letter of integrity from a teacher/coach and a letter from a non-family member along with a copy of their most recent transcript.
5. Scholarship award must be used for school related expenses including, but limited to, tuition, room and board, books and lab fees.

Scholarships will not exceed \$500.00 annually, and is not renewable. Recipient(s) is eligible to win only one time. If funds are not available in any given year for granting a new scholarship, final determination will be at the discretion of the Scholarship Committee. Scholarship will be awarded at the beginning of recipient(s) first semester of school.

Applications for scholarships will be made available by contacting either a committee member or through your race club and must be submitted no later than March 31st of each year. The Committee will award the scholarship on or before May 1, via letter to race club and applicant.
